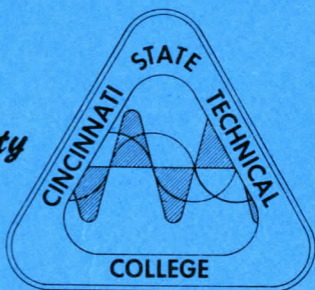

HOW TO ENROLL

1. Obtain an application form and two recommendation forms from your high school counselor or from Cincinnati Technical Institute's Admission office.
2. Complete the application form and mail it or take it to the Admissions Office. (A nonrefundable \$10 application fee must accompany the form.)
3. After you apply for admission, ask your counselor to send your high school transcript to the Institute.
4. Ask two adults familiar with your performance at school or work to complete and mail the recommendation forms to the Admissions Office.
5. Take the entrance examination at the earliest possible date. Check the catalog for the list of dates on which the examinations are scheduled.
6. Await notification from the Institute of an appointment for a pre-enrollment interview with the coordinator of the program in which you wish to enroll or with a member of the Admissions Office Staff.

The appointment will be made after the following have been received from you:

- Application
- Two recommendations
- High School Transcript
- Entrance Examination scores

Applicants must qualify for the program they elect. Those with marginal qualifications may be admitted on a probationary basis.
